



## Covid Policy

Admittance to the Leduc Drama Society building, for both rehearsals & performances will require the following:

- Proof of vaccination (2 doses). Children over the age of 5 must show proof of their first dose of vaccination.

*OR*

- Proof of a privately-paid negative PCR or rapid test within 72 hours of admittance. Rehearsal purposes will accept at home covid tests.

*OR*

- Documentation of a medical exemption.

Proper use of masks or face coverings will continue to be mandatory at this time.

For those members participating as cast, crew, volunteers or board members must also report to the director if they have received a positive test or come in close contact. Close contact for these purposes will be defined as within 6 feet for in excess of 15 min over 3 days.

Directors will report close contact and positive test results to the president who will be responsible for informing those who may have also been in close contact.

In cases of close contact a negative test (rapid or PCR) must be provided prior to resuming in person activities.

In cases of positive tests either a negative test result must be provided or 10 days must have passed following the end of symptoms before being allowed to return to in person activities.

It will be at the director's discretion on whether a cast member will have missed too much time and need to be recast.
