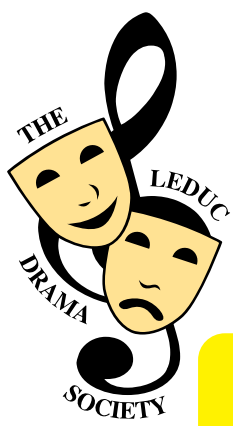

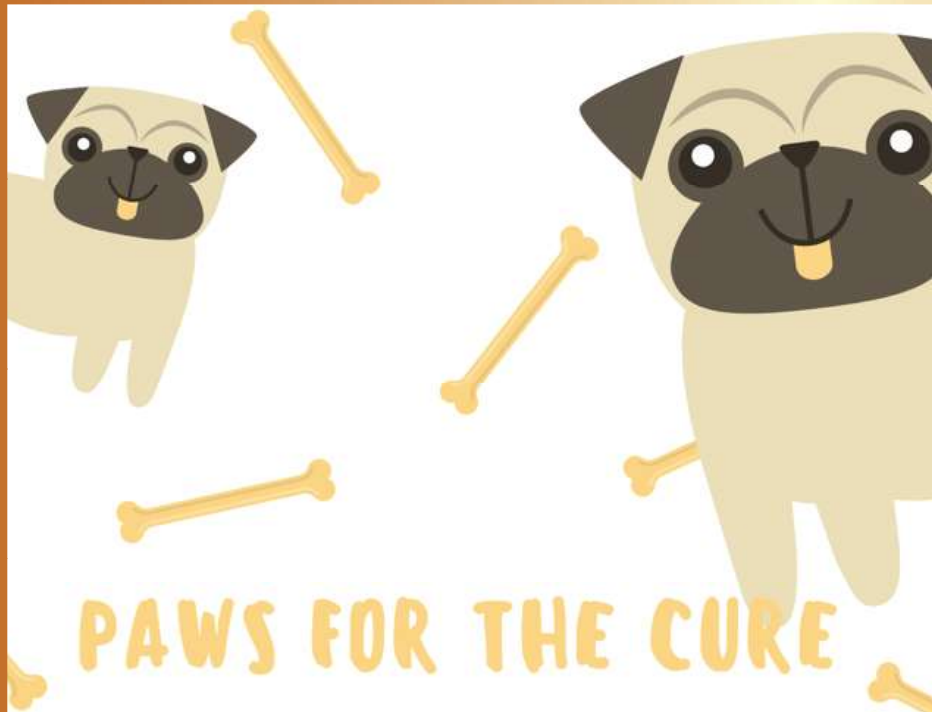
If you have ever wanted to direct a play, this could be your chance.
